How to order a love note:

- If you would like our staff to design:
 - 1) Select a size based on the number of photos and text you wish to include.
 - 2) Clearly fill out the contents of this form and print your message exactly as you wish it to appear in the book.
 - 3) **Print your name and address on the back of your photos.** Do not cut your photos or staple them to this sheet, as the holes will be visible when we scan the photos. We will crop them to the appropriate size.
 - 4) Photos will not be returned until after May 2024 so that love notes will be a surprise.
 - 5) Include payment of cash, check or money order, payable to Holt Public Schools.
