

SENIOR YEARBOOK PHOTO INFORMATION

Senior pictures must be submitted through Jostens or emailed to Mrs. DeVuyst, yearbook advisor, by **December 1st, 2025**. Any photo submitted after this date is subjected to a \$20 late fee and NOT guaranteed to appear in the yearbook. Please read the following specifications carefully. For consistency of production on the color senior pages, the yearbook portraits must meet these specifications:

YEARBOOK SENIOR PORTRAIT SPECIFICATIONS

1. Choose a standard, formal **head-and-shoulders** photo. Photos that are submitted with a full-body pose will be cropped down to head-and-shoulders, which can effect resolution.
2. **Electronic copies are required, no physical copies permitted. We cannot use an image that has a copyright notice on it, so please send an approved version.** Make sure your photographer knows you need a yearbook print. They will make a special electronic copy for yearbook use.
3. Do **NOT** send a screenshot. They are not of a high enough resolution to be used in the book. It must be an original digital image.
4. Our senior portrait section is a formal section of the yearbook, so we ask that the background is simple and does not distract from the student. We do not accept photos with props, trucks, shotguns, horses, dogs, musical instruments, sports equipment, or any other items for the portrait section.
5. Senior portraits submitted to yearbook **WILL NOT** be returned and are completely digital. Please save a copy before submitting your image.
6. All portraits must be received by the yearbook advisor by **December 1st, 2025**. Please submit all images through the yearbook link: <https://www.yearbooknerds.com/flushing-high-school>
7. If you are unsure about getting senior pictures, you can get your picture taken on the school picture day for no cost. This picture will be used in the yearbook unless we receive an official senior photo. Otherwise, if no picture is submitted, there will be no picture in the yearbook.
8. Once you have sent an image, you will receive an email confirmation that we have received and approved the content. If you do not get an email, there is no guarantee that we have your photo. Please confirm if you do not hear from us.

Note for parents: For your own convenience, most area portrait studios will prepare and send digital images to us. Check to see if your photographer plans to do this. We highly recommend scheduling your portrait sittings for the summer or early fall. Seniors will be very busy next year and the time will fly by.
