## **SENIOR PICTURE REQUIREMENTS**

SALINE HIGH SCHOOL

There are **two options** for **senior** picture submission for the yearbook. You can choose to use the photo taken by SchoolPictures.com when your senior picks up their schedule in August, or you can submit a photo from an outside photographer. Please see the details below.



## **OPTION #1:** Use Your PowerSchool Picture

- 1. All seniors will have a head-and-shoulders-only picture taken in late August when they pick up their schedules.
- 2. The retouched head-and-shoulders-only photo will be submitted to the yearbook by SchoolPictures.com. If you are choosing this option, **there is nothing else you need to do** for the picture to appear in the yearbook.
- 3. Picture retake days are during all three lunches on Sept. 29 and 30. If you missed August, you can also get your picture taken during this time.
- 4. You can go to <a href="www.SchoolPictures.com">www.SchoolPictures.com</a> to order prints of the picture for your own personal use. A link to proofs of each student's individual photo will be emailed if no previous order was placed. These proofs will be available to view and order beginning in early September.

## **OPTION #2:** Submit Your Own Senior Picture

**DUE SUBMITTED BY NOV. 1** Make sure that your photographer is aware of **the following specifications**.

	Yearbook portraits should include <b>head and shoulders only</b> . <b>NO HATS, NO PROPS, NO LETTER JACKETS, NO</b>
	B&W PORTRAITS, NO TREE BRANCHES ACROSS THE FACE.
	Pictures that include props (lacrosse stick, truck, pet, etc.) or letter jackets will <u>not</u> be accepted for the senior section.
	<i>However</i> , you can choose to purchase an <b>"Ad for Grad"</b> for your senior, which can include a variety of pictures and messagesvisit our website to find out how to purchase an ad.
	5X7 aspect ratio is the most popular size we use. Photos must be at least 300 dpi in resolution.
	Natural or outside backgrounds are acceptable, but please make sure lighting shows student's face clearly.
	The student <b>must be facing the camera</b> not walking away from the camera while turning around, etc.
	With outdoor portraits, there should be nothing in the foreground (leaves, etc.) that block the student's face.
	Click <u>HERE</u> or go <u>https://www.yearbooknerds.com/saline-high-school</u> to upload your photo. Only upload <u>ONE</u>
	photo.
	<b><u>DEADLINE:</u></b> Photos must be uploaded per the instructions NO LATER THAN <b>NOV. 1.</b> While some photographers
	deliver photos to us, it is ultimately <u>your</u> responsibility to get them to the yearbook staff on time. Photos that are
	submitted AFTER NOV. 1 may not be published in the yearbook because of printing plant deadlines.
